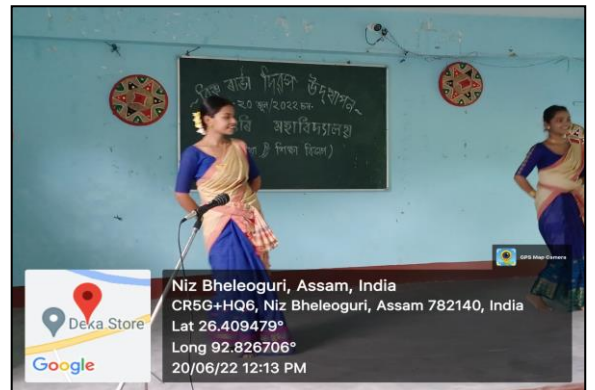
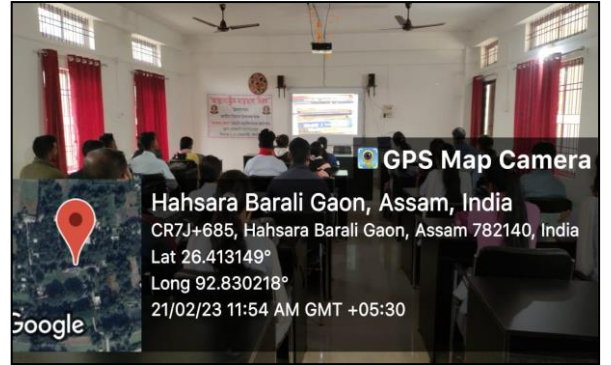
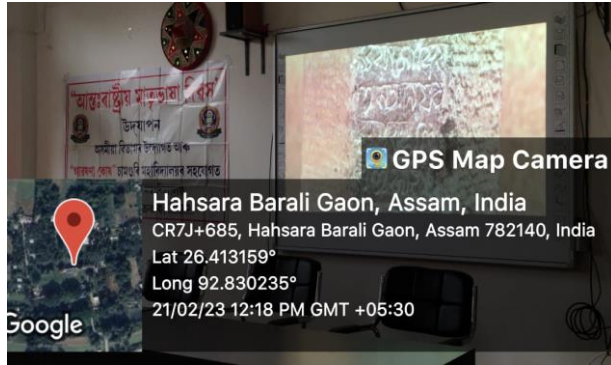
4. Evidence of success:

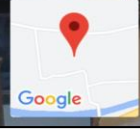
The continuous effort of the college fraternity has made the entire college campus green and it became the abode of birds and reptiles. The adopted village is clean and green everywhere.

5. Problems encountered and resources required:

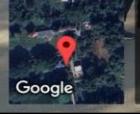
The problem encountered while implementing the green initiatives are unavailability of good sapling for plantation and lack of fund to undertake continuous plantation dive.

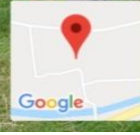

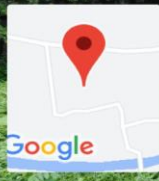
